2 Notification Steps:

- a. Capture Name and Description.
- b. Notify command via Radio.
- c. Give Description as recorded in section 1-a and 1-b above.
- d Command will confirm the information, and notify BPD.
- e. Capture Description 1-c through 1-e and report via radio.
- f. Command will confirm the information and notify BPD

Note: The staff member with a radio must accompany the reporting person until the child is found.

The Decision to release the child to an adult is made ONLY by Beaverton Police.

LOST PARENT PROCEDURE

When a child reports a lost parent.

- 1. The staff member will notify command via radio.
- 2. The staff member will accompany the child on a search of the immediate area.
- 3. The staff member will then escort the child to a location designated by Command or release the child to BPD custody.
